- 1. Welcome and introductions

- 5. New Librarian Series: Katie & Susan
  - a. Katie & Susan are working with Jessica Trujillo to develop the New Librarian panel series for NJLA's Youtube Channel.
  - b. Scheduling for the New Librarian Series went out in mid-August and ended on August 25th. The scheduling survey got 19 responses. Jessica Trujillo is currently working on sending out a poll with times to schedule the panelists for the New Librarian Series. She should have an update for us soon!

- 6. Debunking Misinformation Program Susan & Katie spoke to Carina on August 31st to discuss this possible program. Katie asked Carina if she had any expectations for the program and she said she was trusting the PD Committee to handle the program. It was discussed if we should do a program since a similar one was being run by LLNJ in their Virtual Fall Conference on September 27th. Susan asked Katie to reach out to Darby to learn more about the particulars about the program. During the meeting, it was discussed seeing if the authors of <a href="The Debunking Handbook">The Debunking Handbook</a> would be interested in doing a program for NJLA.
  - a. Here is Darby's reply:

"Thanks for reaching out! The presentation will be a shortened version of one that I saw at ALA this year. Two academic librarians/researchers from the University of Washington will be joining us to talk about a project that focuses on teaching information literacy skills. This is the description of the presentation they submitted with their proposal:

"This presentation will share lessons and resources from a multi-year research project focused on digital and information literacy. The project is a collaboration with librarians and K12 educators to develop innovative approaches to using information literacy to address misinformation and the social divisions it produces. Many existing literacy approaches are too narrowly framed, and fail to account for how misinformation exploits not only our minds but also our emotions, identities, and social relationships. This project is developing approaches to equip people with the critical thinking skills they need to assess the truthfulness of information, and also skills to reflect on their social and emotional attachments to information. This offers a more holistic approach for addressing misinformation and its many social and personal impacts. The session will draw on this project to share practical tips for engaging your patrons on the topic of misinformation, and highlight resources for implementing new digital literacy programming."

- b. Katie and Susan think this is similar enough to Carina's proposal that it is not necessary to offer our own programming at this time. Katie will reach out to Darby about posting the link to the program on our PD page, and possibly a more permanent document link.
- c. Matheson suggested also linking to the Lateral Reading presentation that LLNJ gave today at the Virtual Literacy Conference.

#### 7. Surveys & Future Programming: Katie & Susan

- a. June Marketing Survey updates: Survey deadline was June 30th. We collected 20 responses. Results will be posted to the PD page and answers will be sent to those who require a response.

Kate has reached out several times to Cassie and has not yet heard back. Kate will reach out to Adriana Mamay, and Christina may have a few other people we could ask (Jennifer Sulligan?)
- iii. Further surveys will be put on hiatus for the time being while we focus on reviewing data already collected and developing related programs.
