LibraryLinkNJ Updates for NJLA Section & Round Table Meetings

The Future of LibraryLinkNJ

- A brief snapshot of results from our <u>Save LLNJ Survey</u>, which closed on 9/20: Would you support the library community prioritizing its funding request to the legislature to identify stable, ongoing funding for LibraryLinkNJ as the top priority for library funding in FY2019 and FY2020?
 - Total responses: 689
 - YES: 94% (645)
 - NO: 6% (44)

Background information: LibraryLinkNJ has adopted a budget for July 2018 -June 2019 that requires libraries participating in delivery services to contribute to its cost for the period January 1, - June 30, 2019.

The current budget - even with library contributions for delivery – is still \$370,000 short of full funding for LibraryLinkNJ. This deficit is the result of several unfortunate circumstances, including an increase in the cost of services and continued flat funding from the state. In years past, we have made up for any deficits through reserve funding. That funding, however, has now run out.

If additional funding is not secured and secured soon, LibraryLinkNJ will close for good. LibraryLinkNJ has already had to put a contingency plan in place, with staff layoffs starting in January 2019 and with LibraryLinkNJ dissolving entirely in June 2019. There is great uncertainty regarding the future of all of the services LibraryLinkNJ provides: delivery, continuing education, innovation projects, and a voice for advocacy for the entire library community as a whole.

LibraryLinkNJ is funded through the Network Aid line in the State Library's budget. That budget line funds a number of other services in addition to LibraryLinkNJ.

We are doing this survey in hopes of demonstrating that there is a high level of consensus among the library community to sustain funding for LibraryLinkNJ and its services into the future. We appreciate your time and hope you will join our efforts to save LibraryLinkNJ!

- Advocacy Form: Action Item open until further notice. We're gathering stories from staff at member libraries about the difference LibraryLinkNJ has made in your careers and in your libraries' abilities to serve your communities. If you have a specific story to share about LibraryLinkNJ services -- continuing education, innovation project funding, and delivery -- we'd love to hear from you!
