Cara mentioned CUS has worked with Mentor NJ through Darby at LLNJ. Marissa mentioned talking to Stephanie about doing a LLNJ Skill Share regarding Sustainable Libraries or other sustainable topics.

Larissa submitted a Seed Library proposal to NJLA.
